

HOW OLD CAN AN ENTRY BE FOR A COMPETITION?

SET SUBJECTS

Once the Set Subjects are selected at the AGM, (for example May 2019 AGM - 2020/2021 season), from that date, you are able to take photographs in preparation for that season.

The table below outlines the starting date applicable for eligible entries in the given season:

DATE	SEASON
May 2019	2020-2021
July 2020 (<i>due to Corona</i>)	2021-2022
May 2022	2023-2024
May 2023	2024-2025

This is applicable to both Digital & Printed images.

OPEN COMPETITIONS

Digital and printed images can be of any age but must not have been entered into any previous Set Subject or Open Competition. We enter the Rosebowl Competition run by The Chiltern Association of Camera Clubs (CACC) where entries must not have been first entered into our club competitions more than two years previously. Therefore in order to have a good selection of images from club members to pick our entries from, it was agreed a few years ago that to encourage members to go out and take photos and to keep images up to date, there would be a two year rule on Set Subjects only.

The Open entries are not impacted by this ruling thereby giving members a chance to show/enter their work that otherwise may end up on a backup disc.

ALPHABET COMPETITION (THE EDITH WARD TROPHY)

Digital and printed images must have been taken within the last twelve months.

THREE OF A KIND

There are no restrictions on which prints may be entered in this competition. Individual entries in a previous year's competition are eligible to make up a set of three images. *Both the Alphabet and Three of a Kind competition entries can previously or subsequently be entered into a Set or Open Competition as their scores do not count towards the Photographer of the Year award.
